

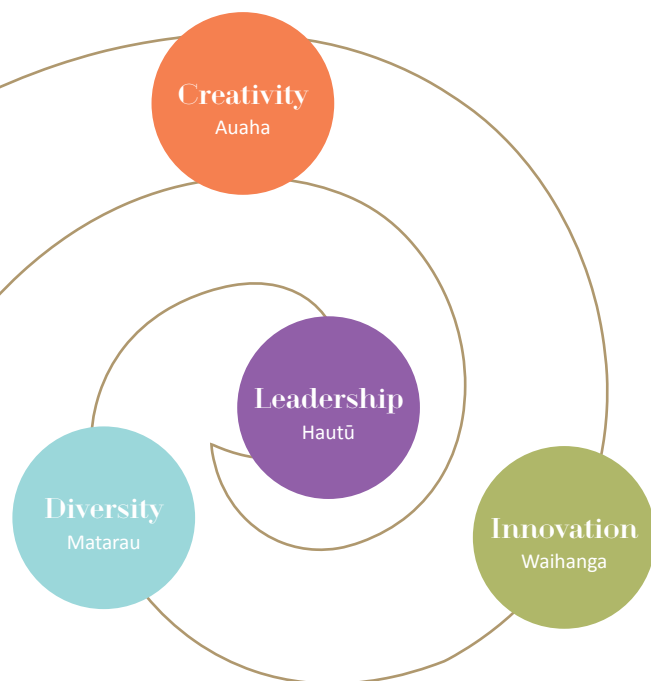


Governor-General's Strategy 2016 -2021
