The New Zealand Nurses' Memorial Fund Inc. is a benevolent fund which has given financial assistance to nurses in hardship since 1917 and continues to do so today.

The Fund was founded as a practical memorial to the 10 nurses who drowned when the SS Marquette was torpedoed in the Aegean Sea in October 1915.

Money was raised throughout New Zealand to establish the Fund and today it continues to support nurses throughout New Zealand.
